

Supply List

IMPORTANT: Please call 780-428-1111 before purchasing supplies to ensure the class is running.

Students must bring their own paintings to work on in the classroom. The subject, technique, style is up to the individual student. The instructor will advise and, when necessary, help each student to bring their own individual art projects to completion.

YOU WILL NEED TO BRING:

OIL / ACRYLIC PAINTS - Bring to class any oil and/ or acrylic colours that you plan to use.

BRUSHES – Depending on the style and dimensions of your paintings, you will need to adjust the softness and size of your brushes.

MEDIUM

1. Oils: Liquin, Linseed Oil or any Alkyd Medium
2. Acrylics: any suitable medium.

For impasto (heavy application of paint) effects, cold wax (oils) or acrylic gel gloss (acrylics) is recommended.

CANVAS - Number, size and dimensions up to the personal needs of the student.

Other Materials

1. Palette:
 - medium size wooden, glass or plastic (oils)
 - shallow container with a sponge and lid or many large ceramic/plastic plates (acrylics)
2. Small jar (such as cosmetics jar) with a lid for the medium
3. Paper towels
4. Palette knife
5. Bar of soap or liquid dishwasher detergent
6. A piece of sand paper (medium soft)
7. Shallow plastic container with a lid for carrying the palette (a pizza box will do as well) (oils)
8. Min. 250 ml. GAMSOL: Gamblin's odorless mineral spirits (oils)
9. One jar filled half through with some rice, dry beans or sand to hold the dirty brushes (oils)
10. Bar of soap or liquid dishwasher detergent
11. Small shallow plastic container with a lid (i.e. 250 ml sour cream container)
12. Easel (to set up on the table)
13. Plastic table clothes (from dollar store) to cover the surface of the tables while painting
