YOU WILL NEED TO BRING:

PAINT (oils or acrylics)

Any colour that you have, though the essentials are:

Titanium White	Burnt Umber & Raw Umber
Lemon or Hansa Yellow	Phthalo Green
Cadmium Yellow Med.	Ultramarine Blue
Yellow Ochre	Cerulean Blue
Cadmium Red Light (Medium if it is too	Phthalo Blue
orange)	
Alizarin Crimson & Quinacridone Red	Dioxazine Purple
Venetian Red & Burnt Sienna	Ivory or Mars Black

Note: It will be advantageous for those who prefer using oils, to have a basic set of acrylics for priming canvases and to set up the colour composition.

I. PALETTE KNIVES / BRUSHES

- 1. The Medium Size Palette Knife (diamond shaped blade): used the most
- 2. Synthetic brushes (one small pointed, 1/8", ¼", ½", ¾" filbert and/or flat)

II. MEDIUM

1. Oils: Linseed oil or Liquin

2. Acrylics: acrylic glazing medium

III. CANVASES

- Minimum 5 canvases or panels 10"×12" or larger for studies.

IV. MISCELLANEOUS

- 1. Palette:
 - medium size wooden, glass or plastic (oils)
 - shallow container with a sponge and lid or many large ceramic/plastic plates for acrylics
- 2. Spray bottle (acrylic paint)



- 3. Paper towels
- 4. Min. 250 ml. GAMSOL: Gamblin's odorless mineral spirits (oils)

V. ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

Supplies may be purchased at any place of your choice; however, supplies should be available at most art stores. When purchasing supplies remember to bring your class receipt; many art stores offer a discount to students. Some supplies may also be found at your local dollar store (i.e. Dollerama).
