**IMPORTANT: Please call 780-428-1111 before purchasing supplies to ensure the class is running.**

**You will need to bring:**

- **PAINT (oils or acrylics)**

- Any colour that you have, though the essential are:

| Lemon/ Hansa Yellow | Phthalo Green                      |
| Cadmium Yellow Med. | Ultramarine Blue                   |
| Yellow Ochre        | Cerulean Blue                      |
| Cadmium Red Med.    | Phthalo Blue                       |
| Alizarin Crimson    | Dioxin Purple                      |
| Venetian Red        | Ivory/ Mars Black                  |

It will be to advantage for those who prefer using oils to have a basic set of acrylics to use them for priming canvases and set up the colour composition.

- **PALETTE KNIVES / BRUSHES**

1. The Medium Size Palette Knife (diamond shaped blade): used the most
2. The Small Palette Knife: to paint tight small areas or objects such as flower petals
3. Bristle brush medium and small (filbert shape)

- **MEDIUM**

1. Oils: Linseed oil and preferable cold wax
2. Acrylics: acrylic medium and preferable acrylic gel gloss (regular or soft)

- **CANVASES**

1. Canvases and / or MDF boards: minimum 6 of any size between 12"x14" and 18"x24"

- **MISCELLANEOUS**

1. Palette:
  - a. medium size wooden, glass or plastic (oils)
  - b. shallow container with a sponge and lid or many large ceramic/plastic plates for acrylics
2. Spray bottle (acrylic paint).
3. Paper towels
4. A piece of sand paper (medium soft)
5. Min. 250 ml. GAMSOL: Gamblin's odorless mineral spirits (oils)

**Supplies may be purchased at any place of your choice; however, supplies should be available at most art stores. When purchasing supplies remember to bring your class receipt; many art stores offer a discount to students. Some supplies may also be found at your local dollar store (i.e. Dollerama).**
