

Supply List

Class Name: Acrylic – Streetscapes Workshop

IMPORTANT: Please call 780-428-1111 before purchasing supplies to ensure the class is running.

Workshop runs 6 hours so please bring a bag lunch.

YOU WILL NEED TO BRING:

- 1 or more 8 x 10" or 9 x 12" canvas board or prepared canvas for your painting project or whatever size you wish to work on.
- 1 or more cheap canvas boards from the dollar or art store are great for practise/exercises
- Palette or white plates to mix paint on (to keep your acrylic palette from drying out you will need a large airtight plastic container that your palette fits into).
- 2 Water containers
- Spray bottle (fine mist)
- Pencil and eraser
- Graphite transfer paper (some will be available from the instructor)
- Paper towels, absorbent rags or clothes and or sponges
- Plastic table cover or newspaper

BRUSHES:

Bring all brushes you have available – (I use a variety of watercolour, acrylic and oil brushes)

OR:

- One 1" flat soft brush
- One ¼ - ½" flat or round bristle brush
- 2 round soft brushes – smaller size 4 or 6 and larger size 10 or 12 (these #'s refer to short handle brushes)
- One or two flat acrylic blending brushes approx. ¼ - ½"
- One script liner or small detail brush
- Palette knife (optional)

PAINT:

I use Golden Heavy Body Acrylics that are a professional grade of paint. There are many types of acrylic paints available so the choice is yours. Quality and lightfastness are factors that will affect the price you pay. Liquitex or Grumbacher Academy are cheaper alternatives to Golden with reasonable quality.

BASIC COLORS:

(These are Golden Colours and some brands may have other names so ask store staff to help you to select a similar colour choice)

- Titanium White,
- Primary Yellow or Hansa Yellow,
- Quinacridone or Alizarin Crimson,
- Phthalo or Cerulean Blue,
- Jenkins Green or Phthalo Green,
- Burnt Sienna

OPTIONAL COLORS ARE:

- Yellow Ochre or Quinacridone Gold,
- Pyrrole Orange or Cadmium Orange,
- Cadmium Red,
- Dioxazine Purple,
- Ultramarine Blue, and any other colours you may have.

Students should bring any other acrylic supplies they have available in addition to what is listed.

Supplies may be purchased at any place of your choice, however supplies should be available at most art stores. When buying supplies remember to bring your class receipt. Many art stores offer a discount to students.
