

Supply List

Class Name: Watercolour Autumn Leaves

IMPORTANT: Please call 780-428-1111 before purchasing supplies to ensure the class is running.

Workshop runs 6 hours so please bring a bag lunch.

YOU WILL NEED TO BRING:

PAPER:

140 lb Arches Medium - Cold Pressed, or similar quality (good paper is very important, so it is best to purchase a full sheet or 2 of watercolour paper rather than cheaper student grade booklets

OR

aquabord panels by Ampersand. I like the square format and suggest $6" \times 6" - 10" \times 10"$ or any size you prefer. If you want to paint a pair of leaves, you need at least 2 panels BUT you will need to bring w/c paper as well to do some exercises and practise on. If you wish to work on stretched paper please prepare this at home or you may use watercolor blocks.

BRUSHES:

Flat Brush - one approx. $\frac{1}{2}$ " wide – a firm synthetic brush with $\frac{1}{2}$ " long "hair" used for blending and other flat brushes you have.

Round Brushes - approx. sizes #4, #6, #8, #10, #12 (2 - 3 of these will suffice) - One script liner or small detail brush (these numbers refer to short handle brushes)

WATERCOLOUR PAINTS: The quality of paints will affect your final product - if you are just learning and want to experiment first, student quality such as Grumbacher Academy or Cotman are ok. You WILL NOT get superior color results with student grade paints. I use Winsor & Newton (Artist Quality)

SUGGESTED BASIC COLOURS:

- Aureolin Yellow (W&N) or New Gamboge,
- Phthalo Green or Winsor Green (blue or yellow shade),
- Alizarin Crimson,
- Ultramarine Blue or Phthalo Blue (Winsor Blue red shade or green shade),
- Burnt Sienna

OPTIONAL COLOURS:

- Winsor (Dioxazine) Violet or purple,
- Indian Yellow or Quinacridone Gold,
- Yellow Ochre,
- Winsor Orange (Red Shade) or Cadmium Orange



OTHER MATERIALS:

- pencil, eraser
- paper towels, rags, (cellulose sponges are also good for water control)
- palette white plates will do
- 2 water containers and spray bottle (fine mist)
- plastic table cover or newspaper

OPTIONAL ITEMS:

- graphite transfer paper (some will be available to borrow from instructor)
- hair dryer
- masking fluid and bar of soap, masking tape

Students should bring any other w/c supplies they have available in addition to what is outlined above
