Class Name: Oil Painting for Beginners

The following supplies are needed for this class, however, **please DO NOT purchase any supplies until you receive an email from Metro, confirming that the class is running** (periodically classes are cancelled due to low enrollment).

An email confirmation will be sent a minimum of 2 business days prior to the class start date or you will be notified that the class has been cancelled. Please note: If you do not receive an email as stated above, please be sure to check your spam inbox.

YOU WILL NEED TO BRING:

Brushes:

- Hog bristle brushes in flats -sizes: 2, 4, 8 and rounds sizes: 2 and 4.

Materials:

- 4 small boards or canvases: 2 -10"x12" and 2 -12"x16"
- 3-4 palette knives
- Palette paper or plastic palette
- Cup or container for cleaning brushes
- Paper towels or rags for cleaning brushes and hands
- Latex gloves to protect hands (if you don't like getting oil paint or citrus thinner on your hands)
- 10" x 12" sketch book or paper
- 3B pencil
- Eraser

Paints:

- Titanium white
- Cerulean blue (alternate manganese blue only if you have it)
- Permanent red (alternate cadmium red only if you have it)
- Winsor yellow (alternate cadmium yellow medium only if you have it)
- Ultramarine blue
- Quinacridone magenta (alternate alizarin crimson only if you have it)
- Hansa yellow or lemon yellow

Note: We will try to avoid using Cadmium paints in this class so please don't buy cadmium based paints. If you already have them then bring them.

EcoHouse brand Citrus Thinner extra mild #115

Note: Due to sensitivities and allergies we will not use solvents and Linseed oil as a medium in this class. We will use paint straight from the tube or add walnut oil and/or citrus thinner. Please feel free to bring any additional supplies you have. When you are buying supplies, remember to take your Metro class receipt. Many art stores offer a discount to students.
