The following supplies are needed for this class; however, <u>please DO NOT purchase any supplies until you receive an email from Metro, confirming that the class is running.</u>
(Periodically classes are cancelled due to low enrollment). An email confirmation will be sent a minimum of 2 business days prior to the class start date or you will be notified that the class has been cancelled. Please note: If you do not receive an email as stated above, please be sure to check your spam inbox.

YOU WILL NEED TO BRING:

PAINT (oils or acrylics) Any colour that you have, though the essentials are:

Titanium White	Burnt Umber & Raw Umber
Lemon or Hansa Yellow	Phthalo Green
Cadmium Yellow Med.	Ultramarine Blue
Yellow Ochre	Cerulean Blue
Cadmium Red Light (Medium if it is too orange)	Phthalo Blue
Alizarin Crimson & Quinacridone Red	Dioxazine Purple
Venetian Red & Burnt Sienna	Ivory or Mars Black

Note: It will be advantageous for those who prefer using oils, to have a basic set of acrylics for priming canvases and to set up the colour composition.

I. PALETTE KNIVES / BRUSHES

- The Medium Size Palette Knife (diamond shaped blade): used the most
- Synthetic brushes (one small pointed, 1/8", ½", ½", ¾" filbert and/or flat)

II. MEDIUM

Oils: Linseed oil or Liquin

Acrylics: acrylic glazing medium

III. CANVASES

• Minimum 5 canvases or panels 10"×12" or larger for studies.

IV. MISCELLANEOUS

- Palette:
 - medium size wooden, glass or plastic (oils)
 - shallow container with a sponge and lid or many large ceramic/plastic plates for acrylics
- Spray bottle (acrylic paint)
- Paper towels



- Min. 250 ml. GAMSOL: Gamblin's odorless mineral spirits (oils)
- Tablecloth

Supplies should be available at most art stores. When purchasing supplies remember to bring your class receipt as many art stores offer a discount to students. Some supplies may also be found at your local dollar store (i.e. Dollarama).
