

# ART SUPPLY LIST

### Class Name: Palette Knife Painting

The following supplies are needed for this class; however, <u>please DO NOT purchase any supplies until</u> <u>you receive an email from Metro, confirming that the class is running.</u>

(Periodically classes are cancelled due to low enrollment). An email confirmation will be sent a minimum of 2 business days prior to the class start date or you will be notified that the class has been cancelled. **Please note:** If you do not receive an email as stated above, please be sure to check your spam inbox.

#### YOU WILL NEED TO BRING THE FOLLOWING:

**PAINT (oils or acrylics)** Any colour that you have, though the essential are:

Titanium White	Burnt Umber & Raw Umber
Lemon/ Hansa Yellow	Phthalo Green
Cadmium Yellow Med.	Ultramarine Blue
Yellow Ochre	Cerulean Blue
Cadmium Red Med.	Phthalo Blue
Alizarin Crimson	Dioxin Purple
Venetian Red	Ivory/ Mars Black

It would be an advantage for those who prefer using oils to have a basic set of acrylics to use them for priming canvases and set up the colour composition.

#### PALETTE KNIVES / BRUSHES

The Medium Size Palette Knife (diamond shaped blade): used the most

- The Small Palette Knife: to paint tight small areas or objects such as flower petals
- Bristle brush medium and small (filbert shape)

#### MEDIUM

- Oils: Linseed oil and preferable cold wax
- Acrylics: acrylic medium and preferable acrylic gel gloss (regular or soft)

#### CANVASES

• Canvases and / or MDF boards: minimum 6 of any size between 12"×14" and 18"×24"

## MISCELLANEOUS

- Palette:
  - a. medium size wooden, glass or plastic (oils)
  - b. shallow container with a sponge and lid or many large ceramic/plastic plates for acrylics

# MISCELLANEOUS (cont'd)

- Spray bottle (acrylic paint).
- Paper towels
- A piece of sand paper (medium soft)
- Min. 250 ml. GAMSOL: Gamblin's odorless mineral spirits (oils)
- Tablecloth

When purchasing supplies remember to bring your class receipt; many art stores offer a discount to students. Some of the art materials can be found in Dollarama/ Dollar stores.
