Classes at Argyll Centre are only recommended for current Argyll students and are **not** available to students 20 years or older on September 1, 2018.

****Withdrawals:** *If you withdraw before your class begins your \$40 program fee will be withheld. If you complete a withdrawal form after the starting date of class, but before the start of the 4th class, over 20 students only will be refunded 50 percent of their tuition fees. The \$40 program fee will be withheld. No refunds will be issued after the 4th class. The \$100 textbook deposit, if applicable, will be refunded upon return of books.*

All efforts will be made to accommodate the student at another site. If Metro cancels a class, a full refund will be issued. Refunds take up to four weeks for processing through Edmonton Public Schools Financial Services.

Transfers A \$40 processing fee per class is charged for a student-requested transfer.

Course Load One 5-credit course or two 3-credit courses is a maximum load for summer learning. For classroom-based courses full attendance is required and is essential for success.
