The following supplies are needed for this class, however, <u>please DO NOT purchase</u> any supplies until you receive an email from Metro, confirming that the class is running (periodically classes are cancelled due to low enrollment).

Please note: If you do not receive an email as stated above, please be sure to check your spam inbox.

YOU WILL NEED TO BRING:

- Pencils: Artist's graphite 2H, HB, 2B and 4B pencils (eg: Staedtler, Faber Castell, or Derwent)
- Standard pencil sharpener (manual or battery operated)
- Erasing tools: gray kneaded eraser or gum eraser
- Paper: one large sketchbook, approx. 9" x 12" or 11" x 14" is recommended OR any inexpensive drawing paper, cut to approx. 9" x 12" in size. (you will need approximately 10 to 15 pieces)
- 12 to 18 inch ruler (clear works best)
- Blending tools: One paper stomp/tortillon, can be any size
- Stylus optional
- Brush called a drafting or eraser brush optional

We will be drawing on tables. If you prefer to draw on an upright surface, you may bring a drawing board and tape.

Please feel free to bring any additional supplies you have.
