

## Supply List

**Class Name:** Coloured Pencils Workshop: Forest Scene

*The following supplies are needed for this class; however, **please DO NOT purchase any supplies until you receive an email from Metro, confirming that the class is running** (Periodically classes are cancelled due to low enrollment). An email confirmation will be sent a minimum of 2 business days prior to the class start date or you will be notified that the class has been cancelled. **Please note:** If you do not receive an email as stated above, be sure to check your spam inbox.*

- **Please bring the following supplies to class:** (If you have more colours, please bring them to class).
- One or two 10" x 11" pieces of Stonehenge Paper – Black (a 22" x 30" sheet will cut into six 10" x 11" pieces)
- Coloured Pencils - must be artist's quality (eg: Prismacolor Premier, Derwent Coloursoft, or Faber Castell Polychromos)
- Suggested colours for this project: Prismacolor Premier pencils in the following colours (similar colours may be substituted).
  - White 938
  - Canary Yellow 916
  - Black 935
  - Light Umber 941
  - Kelly Green 1096 and/or Limepeel 1005
  - Chartreuse 989
  - Orange 918
  - Poppy Red 922
- A pencil sharpener that works with coloured pencils (recommendation: Prismacolor manual sharpener with vestibule or Koh-i-noor 3-hole manual sharpener)
- 1 kneaded eraser (Optional) - Eraser (drafting) brush
- 1 graphite pencil (2H, H or HB)
- (Optional) - Masking tape (green painters tape works best)
- (Optional) White or Grey transfer paper (can be purchased from the instructor for \$2)

### **Notes/Other:**

*We will be drawing on tables, if you prefer a more upright surface, please bring a drawing board.*

**Tip:** *When buying supplies, remember to take your Metro class receipt. Many art stores offer a discount to students.*
