The following supplies are needed for this class; however, **please DO NOT purchase any supplies until you receive an email from Metro, confirming that the class is running**

(Periodically classes are cancelled due to low enrollment). An email confirmation will be sent a minimum of 2 business days prior to the class start date or you will be notified that the class has been cancelled. **Please note:** If you do not receive an email as stated above, be sure to check your spam inbox.

Please bring the following supplies to class:

- A sewing machine in good working order, the instruction manual, all machine accessories and an empty bobbin
- fabric scissors
- fabric tape measure
- sewing pins
- one spool of white cotton/poly thread “Dual Duty” by Coats
- one package of Schmetz size 12 universal sewing machine needles
- 1 meter of woven, cotton fabric – quilting cotton is ok (NO slippery, stretchy or knit fabrics)
- woven fabrics frays where the fabric is cut
- pen and paper
- ruler

Notes/Other:

The instructor suggests buying your fabric at Fabricland or Marshall's Fabrics.

Tip: When buying supplies, remember to take your Metro class receipt. Many stores offer a discount to students.
