

## Supply List

**IMPORTANT:** Please DO NOT purchase any supplies until you receive an email from Metro, confirming that the class is running (periodically classes are cancelled due to low enrollment). Please note: If you do not receive an email as stated above, be sure to check your spam inbox.

Supplies may be purchased anywhere you choose, however supplies should be available at most art stores (i.e. Delta Art & Drafting, Michaels, The Paint Spot, etc.). When buying supplies, remember to bring your Metro class receipt. Many art stores offer a discount to students. You can also price check online at the various art store websites. Wal-mart and dollar stores also have some art supplies in stock.

**Please bring the following supplies to class** (and feel free to bring any additional supplies you may have):

Sketchbook: ie: Strathmore Visual Journal Mixed Media Sketchbook in size 9"x12"

Papers:

1 package cartridge paper 10"x12" or similar size

1 sheet Watercolour paper

Drawing Supplies:

- Vine charcoal
- Chinese ink
- 1 3B pencil
- 1 black pen (writing pen)
- 1 thick Sharpie
- 3 conte sticks in light medium and dark grey (or sienna or other colour)
- 1 1" acrylic painting brush or whatever bigger brush you have
- 1 size 6 watercolour brush
- 1 cheap oriental painting brush
- acrylic paints: black, white and one or 2 other colours of your choice
- 1 stomp
- 1 kneadable eraser
