The following supplies are needed for this class, however, **please DO NOT purchase any supplies until you receive an email from Metro, confirming that the class is running** (periodically classes are cancelled due to low enrollment).

An email confirmation will be sent a minimum of 2 business days prior to the class start date or you will be notified that the class has been cancelled.

Please note: If you do not receive an email as stated above, please be sure to check your spam inbox.

PLEASE BRING:

- Coloured pencils - **must** be artist's quality (for example: Prismacolor Premier, Derwent Coloursoft, Faber-Castell Polychromos) If you're buying new pencils, I would suggest a set of at least 36 Prismacolor Premier (not verithin or scholar) pencils.
- 1 sheet 22" x 30" **white Stonehenge** drawing paper cut into sixths (equals 6 pieces of 10" x 11") Precut paper can also be purchased from the instructor.
- 1 sheet 22" x 30" **black Stonehenge** drawing paper cut into sixths (equals 6 pieces of 10" x 11") Precut paper can also be purchased from the instructor.
- 1 pencil sharpener that works with your coloured pencils (the soft leads break easily) A Prismacolor manual sharpener with vestibule OR Koh-i-noor 3 blade manual sharpener usually work well.
- 1 kneaded eraser
- 1 graphite pencil (2H, H, or HB)
- 1 sheet of grey transfer paper or a soft graphite stick, and 1 sheet of white transfer paper. (Transfer paper can be purchased from the instructor for \$2 a piece.) – *optional*
- Prismacolor or Derwent colourless blender pencil – *optional*
- eraser or drafting brush – *optional*
- green painter's tape – *optional*

Please feel free to bring any additional supplies you have.
